Act 1

Emma Hames is an isolated victim. Uncontrollable shaking, heart thumping, housebound, stranded.

She retraces her steps in Montpellier where she was wrongfully prescribed a Benzo for 4 years.

The life she lost and still mourns today is one of music, friends and sun.

Act 2

What happened? Who else is out there? A music festival in South France Connecting with other victims online, travelling to hear their story.

Interviewing doctors, pharmacists, families, to understand the pain with brain scans and scientists' input.

Undercover reporting. Victims die - the torture is too much. Where do we go from here?

Act 3

to bring victims together & fundraise for real solutions. Emma's brain scan shows her progress.


